- a. Discussions included: use of A934 coatings for dowels, ASTM A1078 and the introduction of FRP over steel as a competitive system, coating of A1035 (MMFX), continuous galvanized compared with hot dip galvanized.
- Ed Hughes, formerly of IDOT has been retained by IDOT as a consultant on roughcoat.
 Eight projects have been completed using a roughened version of epoxy to minimize deck cracking. A project brief is expected in late 2015.
- c. Participants are required for the EIG booth at World of Concrete. McDonald will be facilitating the staffing by EIG members.
